

The official rules of disc golf can be found on the PDGA website, www.pdga.com/rules. The object of the game of disc golf is to traverse a course from beginning to end in the fewest throws of the disc. The competitor who plays the stipulated round or rounds in the fewest throws plus penalty throws is the winner.

Play on each hole begins at the teeing area and ends at the target. After the player has thrown from the tee, each successive throw is made from where the previous throw came to rest. On completing a hole, the player proceeds to the teeing area of the next hole, until all holes have been played.

SAFETY FIRST

- Never throw when players or park users are within range.
- Always give park users the right of way.
- Be aware of your surroundings and environment.

Please know that you are playing in a City of Tucson park that is utilized by many people, not just disc golfers. Please be courteous when throwing, yell, "Four" when the disc is close to others, be respectful, and follow the rules of the sport and the park.

COURSE COURTESY

- Remain quiet and avoid unnecessary movements while others are throwing.
- Stand behind the player who is throwing until throw is complete.
- Remove disc from Disc Pole Hole® after completing the hole.
- Help new players learn the rules.
- Allow faster groups to play through when possible.
- Pick up trash and put in proper receptacles.
- Do not alter the course (trees, bushes, etc.) in any way.
